

Female Students Before the aggression

Females constituted approximately **49%** of total students in general education

The success rate of female students in secondary education significantly surpassed that of males

More than **60%** of university students were female

Gender gap in favor of females in university enrollment rates



Female Students in the Gaza Strip

Hundreds of thousands of students have been deprived of education, a large proportion of whom are girls

Thousands of female students have completely lost access to a safe learning environment

Psychological trauma among children has risen to unprecedented levels

Destruction or damage to the **majority of schools**



Female Students in the West Bank and Jerusalem

Jerusalem

- **38.3%** of schools were subjected to the occupation's curriculum
- **59.3%** of schools adopt the Palestinian curriculum
- A shortage exceeding **3,700** classrooms

West Bank

- **Repeated incursions and closures** have affected the regularity of schooling
- **Movement restrictions** hinder female students' access to schools



Implications for Girls

- **Widening educational disparities** between regions
- **Long-term** psychological and social consequences
- **Increased risk of dropout** among girls in affected areas
- **A direct threat** to the continuity of girls' educational pathways
