

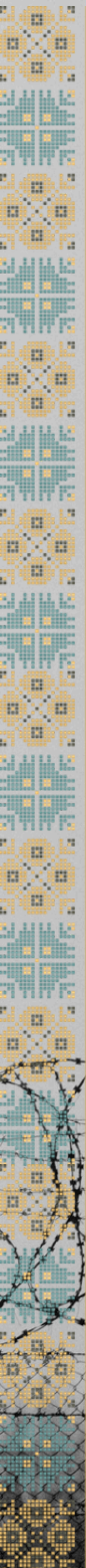


Female Prisoners in Israeli Occupation Prisons

20,000 cases of arrest in the West Bank, including Jerusalem Among them, **595** women

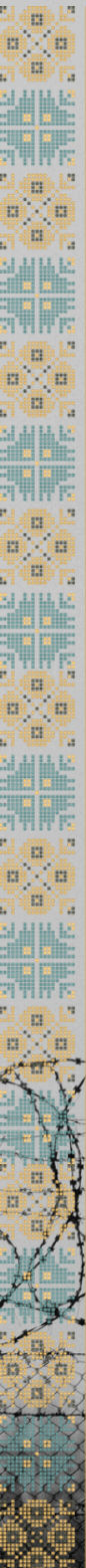
Continued enforcement of the policy of enforced disappearance against female prisoners from **the Gaza Strip**

treatment

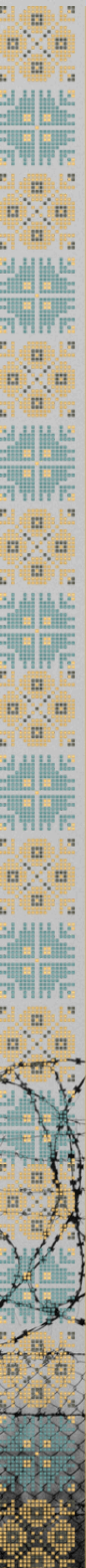
Reliance on painkillers

- Violation of the **Geneva Conventions.**
 - Breach of the **Convention Against Torture.**

- Non-compliance with UN Security Council Resolution **1325 (Women, Peace and Security).**

- Call for the establishment of an **international fact-finding committee.**
 - Demand to enable the International Committee of the Red Cross to have **unrestricted access.**
